

ORAL ROUNDS



Identify the parts of speech

Here, a list of words will be given. The participants are to identify which part of speech each of them is. There are chances that one particular word can be categorized into more than one part of speech.



Listening comprehension

Here, the participants will be made to listen to a sound clip and questions will be asked based on the same.



Mix and match

The student is supposed to match the words to the definitions given in the opposite column. The definitions given are one more than the words. The student should find the apt word for the excess definition.



Word morph

Add or delete one letter from the given word to find a different word. The students are not supposed to use the past tense.



Pick & Spell

To pick and spell maximum number of words within one minute.

HOW DOES THE COMPETITION WORK ?

The competition starts at the school level and moves up to the national level. The students are allowed to attempt both the written and the oral rounds in every stage without any elimination. In the oral round, the participant should score a minimum of 20% in the first round, 40% in the second round, 60% in the third round and 80% in the fourth round to reach the final fifth round. The participants are qualified to the next level of the competition based on the cumulative marks of both written and oral rounds.

MAZE OF WORDS

THE CATEGORIES

The participants will compete in six different categories based on their age. The categorisation is as follows:

English language competitions are generally found to serve a very useful and progressive educational purpose. Students, while participating in these competitions naturally develop important language skills like spelling, familiarity with a larger vocabulary, pronunciation etc.

ABOUT THE COMPETITION

Maze of words competition consists of five written and five oral rounds. The details are as follows.

THE WRITTEN ROUNDS



Words in a word

The student is required to make as many different words as possible using the letters in the given word. The number of repetition of a letter in the new word cannot exceed the number of times a letter appears in the given word.



Jumbled letters and words

The students are required to rearrange the words and the sentences which have been given in jumbled order in order to make meaningful and grammatically correct sentences.



Bulls eye

In this puzzle, a few given alphabets will occupy the centre and slots in the concentric circles. To complete the word the student should fill in the blank slots in concentric circles and form complete words across the centre of the circle.



Word matrix

Two types of incomplete matrixes will be given here. In one, the task is to complete the matrix using one letter that would complete all the words. In the second one, incomplete words will be given which has to be completed using letters that connects it to the next word.



Russian doll

Use the hints given to find the two words which combined will give the right answer.
